INTRODUCTION

Coloursoft pencils have a soft, velvety strip, producing a quick, dense application of bold vibrant colour. The unique formulation is highly blendable, allowing an infinite spectrum of subtly different tones to be created. Available in a choice of 72 rich colours.

MATERIALS USED:

Derwent Coloursoft pencils used:
C300 Indigo, C260 Bright Lilac,
C080 Bright Orange, C180 Blush Pink,
C560 Peach

Somerset Velvet 250gms black paper
Derwent pastel pencil sharpener

1 Using C260 Bright Lilac and pressing very gently, position the distant tree line.

Using C300 Indigo position the foreground trees and fence.



2 Using C080 Bright Orange, a gentle pressure and the side of the pencil, add the sky from the pink upwards.

Sharpen the pencil and, using the point, introduce a little C080 Bright Orange to the top of the horizon and land. Then gently add the C080 Bright Orange to the foreground.

3 Using a firm pressure begin to introduce the C560 Peach. Start at the top of the picture and blend downwards through the C080 Bright Orange to merge into the C180 Blush Pink. Keep the pencil sharp.

4 Using C260 Bright Lilac gently apply the foreground pigment interspersing it with the C080 Bright Orange.

Using C180 Blush Pink soften any distant trees slightly into the sky.
