## Printing with Transfer Paper

Transfer images with a hot iron to virtually any surface – fabric, paper, wood, glass, canvas, metal and more.

- 1. Print, draw or paint on the white side of the transfer paper NB. For use in inkjet printers only.
- 2. Working on a smooth, flat, surface with a pre heated dry iron place transfer paper, image side down on to your material and iron for approximately 1 minute. If using a heat press, press for 20-25 sec. If any areas haven't transferred onto the fabric re iron. You can not over iron.
- 3. Transfer paper must be peeled back while still hot to reveal your design.

For the best appearance, use transfer paper on a high thread count white cotton. You may create your own designs on transfer paper or add to a printed image using felt markers prior to ironing. If you require clear areas you can scratch away the white polymer with a stylus. Once ironed onto fabric you can further embellish with beading, stitching etc.
