

A ONE OFF EASY WAY TO SCREEN PRINT ONTO FABRIC



Lets make screen printing easy for the creative student.

Materials: Silk Screen frame
Rubber squeegee
Daler-Rowney Aquafine watercolour pans
Daler-Rowney System 3 Textile Printing Medium
Fabric to print onto.

Method: Using the Daler-Rowney Aquafine watercolours paint a design onto the outer side of the screen frame. Let dry.
Spread a line of medium along the front of the screen and carefully flood the medium over the image twice holding it above your fabric. Wait 1 minute before printing. Carefully lay the screen onto the fabric and run the squeegee over the frame printing the design onto the fabric. You can spread more medium onto screen and it is possible to get three prints.



Wash screen immediately in cold water. Once dry iron to make print colourfast.

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
