

# Transfer Printing with Colourcraft Transfer Dyes, Paints or Crayons.

Dilute 1 teaspoon of dye powder in 50ml of tepid water.

Paint dye onto cartridge paper and let dry.

Place painted paper face down onto a piece of synthetic fabric and using a heat press , press for 30 seconds.

Heat will transfer the colour from the paper onto the fabric.

You may cut up your paper to create a scene, block out areas with plain paper eg. Clouds and birds on the image below, place leaves on the fabric before printing, cut your painted paper into strips and place them randomly on the fabric or paint your own design on the paper.

Being creative is endless when using this technique.

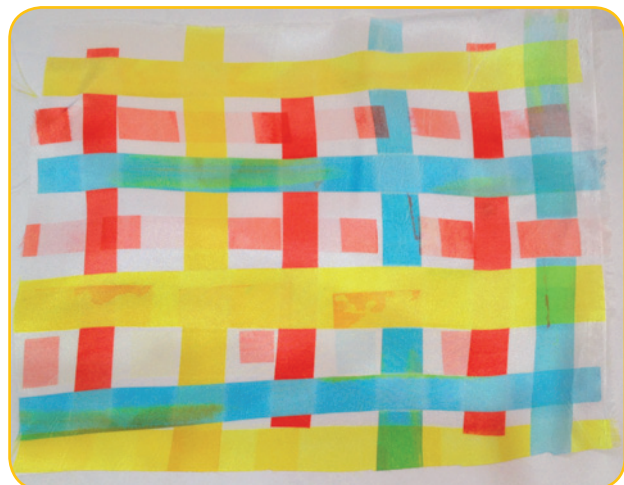
NB: Colours will appear dull on the paper, but transfer brightly.

If you don't have access to a heat press a flat based iron can be used.

When using the transfer paints, use straight from the bottle, no diluting is required.

Simply colour/draw onto the paper with the transfer crayons.

These can be used on their own or in conjunction with transfer dyes and paints.
